He said he thought your affection &

independent and will not yield only to its
own convictions & reasoning -

He said also Parker & Party are in Paris
but ^{& not at same house with A. Phelps.} they only 2 days - will go to England
before sailing for America, will cross the
Atlantic with the A. Phelps.

He said much about Spiritual Manifestation
and of the difficulties the subject presented
to his mind in life - He now saw why he could
not appreciate the evidence he had witnessed of
their reality.
